FOURTH ANNUAL VINTAGE CHARLOTTE WINTER MARKET TO POP UP NOVEMBER 15th

VINTAGE AND HANDMADE SHOPPING EXPERIENCE WITH
60+ LOCAL AND REGIONAL VENDORS

CHARLOTTE (October 19, 2015) – Vintage Charlotte (known by friends and fans as simply: VTGCLT) will be popping up for their fourth annual Winter Market showcasing the best of vintage, eclectic, and handmade. The Winter Market will transform the Fillmore Charlotte on November 15, 2015 into a wonderland of carefully curated goods. This market includes 60+ local and regional vendors of vintage, antique and handmade goods including housewares, furniture, decor, clothing, jewelry and more. In addition to handmade and vintage shopping, there will be food and drink from some of the city's best artisanal purveyors.

In just three and a half years, Vintage Charlotte's pop-up markets have become the place to shop in Charlotte for unique vintage finds and goods from emerging makers. Vendor space at the market is juried and highly competitive. Many shoppers line up before the doors open to get first pick of all of the hard-to-find goods, and the markets now draw upwards of 3,000 customers in a single day.

Founder of Vintage Charlotte, Amy Herman, states that, "Vintage Charlotte is about highlighting the incredibly amazing things going on right here in Charlotte. Every item you find here is either hand selected or expertly made. In supporting these vendors we are supporting the artistic vibrancy and economic viability of our local and regional community. Every item has a story: not only do you get to see these incredible goods, but you get to be face to face with the folks who discover or make them."
